Incoming Student Quota

Length of the study abroad/exchange period at Temple: one (1) year or one (1) semester

Study Abroad: Typically, up to 10 students from one institution at any given time

• Exchange: Typically 4 semesters per academic year (Fall-Spring)*

Admission Criteria for Study Abroad and Exchange Students

- **GPA:** approx. 3.00/4.00 or higher; Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA while enrolled at Temple.
- Undergraduate (bachelor's) students: full-time enrollment at home university for at least 1 academic year
 - Official TOEFL (79 IBT, 550 ITP), IELTS (6.0), or Duolingo English Test (110) scores*
- Graduate (master's) students: case-by-case, please contact us for more details regarding master's students

Semester Dates

Orientation takes place during the week before classes begin. Students will be notified of arrival dates after acceptance. Tentative dates of academic year 2025 at Temple University:
